**Mid-Year Update from your Treasurer**

(as of June 30, 2019)

My last comments to you just after Christmas, at the annual meeting, were a bit grim. At year end, our savings and investing accounts (Start \$2,621,880 – End \$2,199,421) dropped \$422,459 for the year. We had taken \$142,317 from these accounts during the year. We had planned on taking only \$80,000 to pay our bills.

Since then the market has made new highs and the Beers family left a bequest of \$100,000 to Good Hope. Our savings and investment accounts rebounded to \$2,500,382 as of 6-30-2019. However, the S&P 500 is only up 0.86% since October of 2018. We have withdrawn \$70,000 from these accounts, year to date, to pay our bills. Too much, for this point in the year. This number will need increased for next year's budget to be more realistic. Our current investment mix is 60% stock and 40% bond, which was recently adjusted to try to earn more. This risk level is necessary as we pull more from the endowment each year to pay our bills.

Stained Glass Window donations for the first half of 2019 are \$15,571. Goal for the full year is \$50,000 so we are far behind at this point. Extra donations during the Christmas season should help meet the goal. At present we owe United Bank \$106,429 on our window loan.

Weekly offering is \$133,217 for six months. The goal for a full year is \$288,000. This is behind as well. Thanks to all for your gifts to Good Hope so we can carry out God's work in Bucyrus. - Mark Milheim

- **Guest Speakers:** Hollie Daniels, A Survivor, and Ally Suter, owner of Without Borders Boutique in Bucyrus. Ally is big on mission work for trafficking (labor and sexual). She does a lot of work with Nepal and Honduras. She is knowledgeable about many organizations who work to stamp out trafficking and unfair labor practices. She is the area ambassador for Eternal Red Thread. She sells many Fair Trade products as well as products whose profits stay in Ohio to help fight trafficking.

Ally will have merchandise brought from her store, “Without Borders Boutique.” Some products are clothing, scarves, purses, knickknacks. Profit from any purchase you make will go to the effort to stamp out trafficking. Checks, cash, and credit cards will be accepted.

- **Project:** Wrapping soap with rescue information to be placed in motels, rest areas, etc.
- **Why Attend? Who Should Attend?**

Sex Trafficking is a major problem nationwide and close to home in Ohio. Many girls have the normal activities of teenage years interrupted by others who take advantage of their innocence and force them to do unspeakable things. Often lives are ruined or even lost. No race, no socio-economic group, no social class is immune to sex trafficking.

**Because our teens need to understand how men can trick them into sex trafficking, the Southeastern Conference Board is encouraging mothers, grandmothers, and friends--anyone who is close to a teenage gal-- to attend this gathering with them. The subject is unpleasant; education is essential to stop this horrible business of sex trafficking.**
